

AA SCREENING DETERMINATION

Of

Water Network Programme

at

Stranorlar Bridge, Stranorlar, County Donegal

In accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC) and Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, Irish Water has undertaken Appropriate Assessment screening to assess, in view of best scientific knowledge and the conservation objectives of the site, if the project, individually or in combination with other plans or projects is likely to have a significant effect on European Site(s).

The proposed works consist of the rehabilitation of existing watermains at Stranorlar Bridge, Stranorlar, County Donegal. The works are to take place predominantly within the deck of the bridge itself and involves the rehabilitation of approximately 86 m of existing watermain.

In this context, particular attention was paid to the European Site(s) listed below:

- 000129 Croaghonagh Bog SAC
- 002301 River Finn SAC
- UK0030211 Moneygal Bog SAC
- UK0030320 River Foyle and Tributaries SAC

In accordance with Regulation 42(7) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 as amended, **Irish Water has made a determination following screening that an Appropriate Assessment is not required** as the project is not directly connected with or necessary to the management of the sites as European site(s) and **as it can be** <u>excluded</u>, on the basis of objective information and in light of the conservation objectives of the relevant European Site(s), **that the project, individually or in combination with other plans and projects, would have a significant effect on a European Site.**

This determination is based on the nature, location, scale and duration of the proposed works, including any temporary works, and excludes any consideration of mitigation measures.

Full records of the assessment, reports, surveys, consultations, and observations are held by the competent authority and available for public review as requested.
