

WATER SERVICES ACT 2007 (AS AMENDED) — SECTION 56(16)

ORDER MADE BY IRISH WATER UNDER AND PURSUANT TO SECTION 56 (16) OF THE WATER SERVICES ACT 2007 (AS AMENDED)

Irish Water, being of the opinion that a serious deficiency of water available for distribution exists or is likely to exist on a national basis,

HEREBY ORDERS under and pursuant to Section 56(16) of the Water Services Act 2007 (as amended) that, for the specified period set out below and in the area(s) set out in Appendix 1, the use of water supplied by Irish Water for all of the classes of use set out in Column 1 below is prohibited from 8am 6 July 2018 until midnight 31 July 2018. Should the prevailing weather conditions, and likely or actual serious deficiency of water available for distribution continue to persist, it may be necessary to extend the Order to other uses and / or for a longer period of time, by way of a further order pursuant to the Water Services Act 2007 (as amended).

The Order does not apply to water usage where the water being used is not supplied by Irish Water.

The Order made by Irish Water in respect of the Greater Dublin Water Supply Area on 2 July 2018, continues to apply to that area. This Order is made in addition to that Order in respect of all other areas nationwide identified in the map accompanying this Order.

Specified Period: This Order takes effect at 8am on 6 July 2018 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 31 July 2018, subject to the potential necessity for a further period of prohibition and / or restriction, depending on prevailing weather conditions. This Order may be lifted before the specified period if possible, having regard to the prevailing weather conditions and the availability

of water for distribution. Equally, it may be necessary to extend the specified period in time and / or to other water users, by way of additional Order, should the prevailing conditions persist.
