

## **Cork Lower Harbour Main Drainage Project**

### **Information in relation to site set up works**

#### **What works are you doing?**

We are preparing the site area for the Horizontal Directional Drilling to begin. The site will be fenced along the boundary as shown in the sketch, and completely secured. We will be installing a culvert in the Glen Stream to facilitate access in and out of the site area.

#### **What is the culvert?**

The culvert is a structure that allows water to flow under a road from one side to the other. It is approximately 10 metres wide and will be embedded in the stream bank while our work is ongoing. The culvert will allow us to enter and leave the site safely. Upon completion it will be removed and the stream bank will be fully reinstated.

#### **Why are you removing trees?**

It will be necessary to remove 3 or 4 trees to prevent the trees falling and hurting people or damaging property during the drilling works. Upon completion of works we will plant new trees of similar specimen to replace those that were removed. We will ensure replacement trees are as mature as is possible.

#### **Will you be reinstating the basketball court and green area?**

Yes, all areas will be fully reinstated when works are complete.

#### **Will the playground be accessible?**

Yes, the playground and the carpark will remain open throughout the works.
