South Dublin County Council Water Restrictions

The following areas of the South Dublin County Council operational network will continue to have restricted supply resulting in reduction in and/or loss of water pressure from 8pm to 6am.

- **Lucan 750 WSA**

North of Canal, west of M50 as far as, and including the east Lucan areas of Foxborough, Earlsfort and Ballydowd

- **Belgard 750 WSA**

Greenhills, Ballymount, Fox & Geese, Cherry Orchard, Palmerstown, Ballyfermot and Chapelizod areas. Tallaght area (between Belgard Road and M50), Templeogue, Terenure, Crumlin, Walkinstown.

- **Belgard 21" WSA**

Tallaght Hospital and Tallaght town centre are unaffected by restrictions.

The areas impacted are: Fettercairn, Lanndale, Glenshane, Rossfield, Springfield, Whitestown, Aylesbury, Carriglea, Butterfield, Templeroan, Taylors Lane.

Woodtown Reservoir – affecting Woodtown, Mount Venus and Cruagh areas

St Annes pumps affecting Bohernabreena, Friarstown and Montpelier areas

The following areas have NO restrictions applied:

Peamount Reservoir: currently serving Adamstown and the west Lucan areas of Finnstown, Arthur Griffith, Griffeen Valley, Castle Riada, Esker and Haydens Lane. This supply will not be restricted due to the potential for excessive chlorine levels in the reservoir, under the current temporary 2^o chlorination regime, which would then be released to supply at 6am.

Boherboy Reservoir serving the following areas; Newcastle, Baldonnell. Milltown, Saggart, Citywest, Killinarden, Ellensborough, Deerpark, Oldcourt, Orlagh Woodfield, Edmonstown, Whitechurch and Kilmashogue areas
